1. GENERAL

1.1. Organizer

1.1.1. The 6th FAI European Advanced Aerobatic Championships '2009 will take place under the auspices of Aeroclub of Poland.

1.1.2. The operational Organizer is Aeroclub of Radom, Piastow Airfield, 26-660 Jedlinsk, Poland.

1.2. Place and Date

1.2.1. The venue of the 6th EAAC 2009 is the Airfield of Radom (EPRP), in the heart of Poland, about 90 km South from the Capital of Poland - Warsaw. See Item 9th ("How to get to EPRP") or follow the information provided on the EAAC' website (not available yet).

1.2.2. The event will take place in the period of time: August 6th up to 16th, 2009.

1.3. Training Flights

1.3.1 There is a possibility to perform the training flights at Radom Airfield from August 1st till August 6th 2009, up to 18.00 Local Time. The competition box will be marked all this time.

1.4. Schedule

09:00 a.m. – 01:00 p.m.: competition flights;
01:00 p.m. – 02:00 p.m.: lunch break;
02:00 p.m. – up to sunset: competition flights.

15th August

08:00 a.m.: Briefing;
09:00 a.m. – 01:00 p.m.: competition flights;
02:00 p.m. – 05:00 p.m. Air Show;
05:30 p.m.: Awarding and Closing Ceremony;
07:00 p.m. – Closing Dinner.

16th August

Departure of competitors.



Note: in the above Schedule there are 2 additional days included for cancellations of flights as well as for organizational reasons.

Daily Standard Schedule:

- 08.00 a.m.: briefing, pre-flight preparations;
- 09.00 a.m.: up to sunset competition flights;
- 01.00 p.m. to 02.00 p.m.: lunch break.

Note: The above Schedule may be changed due to technical and organizational reasons as well as the weather conditions.

Official working hours for the Organizers are 08.00 a.m. to 13.00 p.m. and 14.00 p.m. to half an hour after the landing of the last competitor. These hours are valid for any official inquiries or information concerning the contest during the contest's period.

All times are to be understood in local times (LT=UTC+2 hrs).

2. REGULATIONS

2.1. Rules

The 6th FAI European Advanced Aerobatic Championships '2009 will be conducted according to the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code – General Section;
- FAI Sporting Code – Section 6;
- Flight Rules published by the Polish Aviation Authorities (CAO);
- Local Regulations.

3. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

3.1 Official Language

The official languages during the 6th FAI European Advanced Aerobatic Championships '2009 are Polish and English. The language of all communications and briefings is English.

4. PARTICIPATION, COMPETITORS AND AIRCRAFT

4.1. Participants

- 4.1.1. All FAI member NACs may be represented at the 6th European Advanced Aerobatic Championships '2009 by the team and/or an individual competitors/observers.
- 4.1.2. The Competitors have to be members of their National Aero Clubs.
- 4.1.3. The Entries will be accepted from National Aero Clubs only.



4.1.4. Each competitor has to be a holder of:

- a valid Pilot License;
- a valid FAI Sporting License;
- a valid personal insurance policy.

4.2. Aircraft

4.2.1. All participating aircrafts have to satisfy performance criteria essential for competition flights for unlimited aerobatics.

4.2.2. For all competing aircrafts a valid Certificate of Airworthiness of the related country has to be presented.

4.2.3. All competing aircraft must have a Certificate of Insurance against Third Party Liability, covering a minimum limit according to EU 785/2004 Directive 8211, valid for the Republic of Poland for the period of staying there.

4.2.4. Hangar space for competing aircrafts will be available free of charge for the period of the Championships.

4.2.5. Fuel AVGAS 100 LL & Oil AeroShell W 100 will be supplied by the Organizer.

5. TEAM COMPOSITION

5.1. Competitors

The Entries for competitors will be accepted from the National Aero Clubs according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6, 1.2.4.1.b.

5.2. Officials

The Officials, as defined in FAI Sporting Code, Section 6, may enter as National Team members.

5.3. Observers

The relatives of competitors will be accepted as observers of National Team. The Entry Fee for observers is the same as for regular team members.

6. ENTRY FEE

6.1. Entry Fees

- Competitor – 1 550 EUR;
- Other team members and observers – 1 300 EUR.

To pay the Entry fees please follow the bank's details provided in Item 10.2.



The entry fee covers:

- Fuel and oil for competition flights;
- Shared accommodation;
- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner;
- Shuttle bus between the airfield and places of accommodation;
- Official and social functions;
- Programmes arranged by organizer.

Note: A single room supplement applies 15 euro per night.

Note: The Entry Fee includes a \$200 CIVA Sanction Fee per pilot.

6.2. Deadline for the Entries

Deadline for the Preliminary Entries: April 1st 2009.

The Official Entry Forms as well as the Entry Fees and Participant's Questionnaires have to be provided to the Organizer no later than May 15th 2009.

Any delays up to June 15th will be charged additionally 100 EUR, any delays up to July 15th 2009 – 150 EUR. If payment is made at the contest site, an additional 200 EUR will be charged.

7. PROTESTS

7.1. Protest Fee

Protest can be submitted by paying of 100 euro.

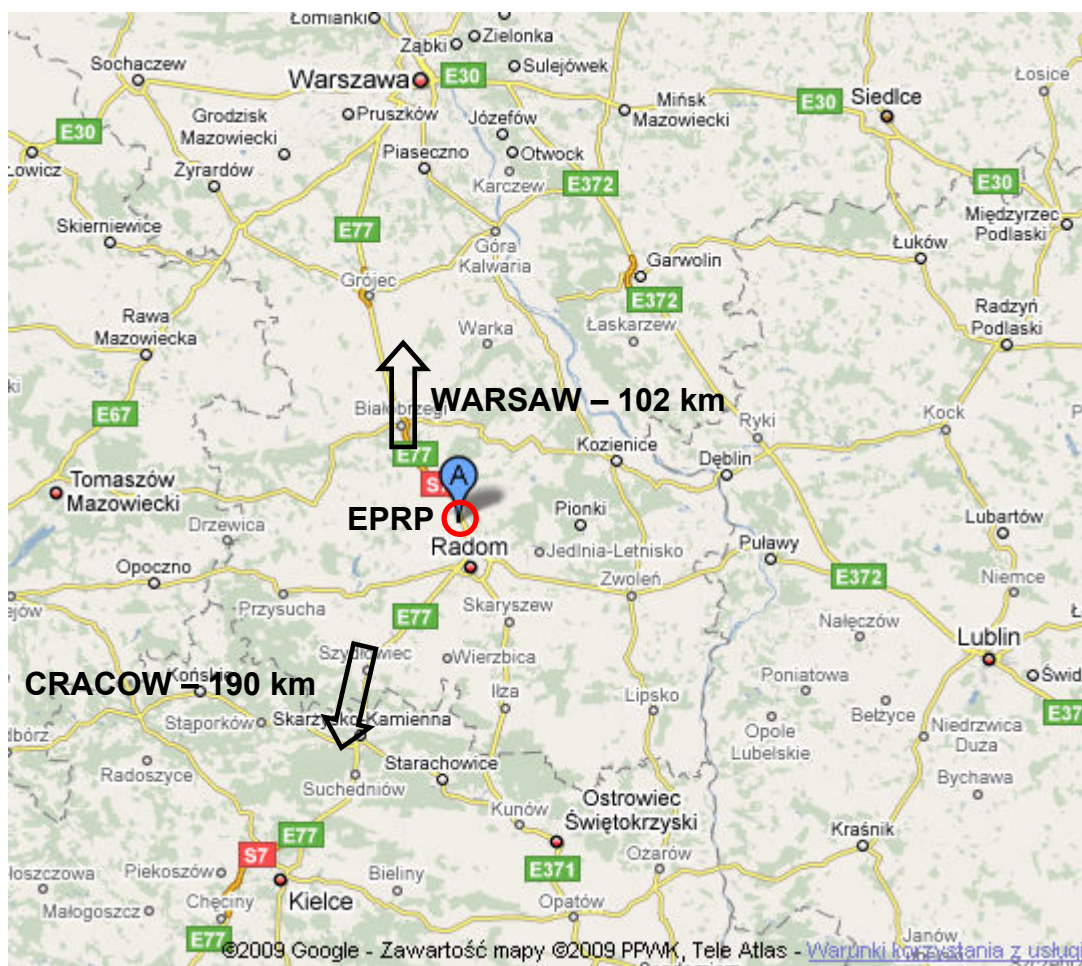

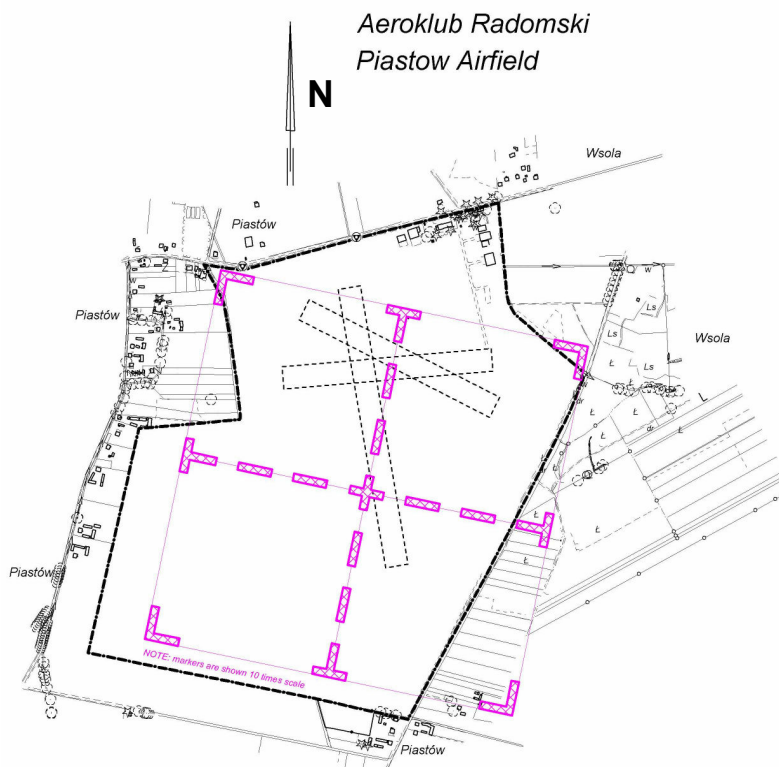
